

Lynchburg College Graduate Credit Opportunity 2013 1 hour credit / \$200 tuition

EDCI 650 PROFESSIONAL LEARNING COMMUNITIES (1 credit hour) Introduction to the concepts that underlie professional learning communities (PLC) and the principles for their application in elementary, middle, and secondary schools. The course is offered in conjunction with participation in training institutes and workshops on PLC.

Please note: The admissions process, payment, course enrollment, and assignment must be completed within 30 days of attending the PLC workshop.

Step 1: Admissions Process

Submit the following **three items** to the Office of Enrollment Services, Lynchburg College, 1501 Lakeside Drive, Lynchburg, VA 24501:

- A. Lynchburg College Graduate Non-degree application for EDCI 650;
- B. An official transcript reflecting your bachelor's or master's degree;
- C. A copy of your certificate of participation from Solution Tree (copies can be obtained from Kim Ennis at Solution Tree. She can be reached at <u>Kim.Ennis@Solution-Tree.com</u>.)

When all items are received and reviewed, your admissions letter will be sent to you via email.

Step 2: Payment/Course Registration

The admissions email will contain *an attachment* with tuition payment information and a form to return to secure enrollment in the course for the applicable term: spring term –January through April; summer term -May through July; and fall term – August through November.

Step 3: Assignment

Once you are enrolled in the course, you will receive an additional email with instructions regarding the electronic submission of the written assignment which requires a 3-5 page summary and critical analysis of the PLC workshop (Word format only). The assignment should include a cover page indicating the name and date of the specific institute/conference attended. **Please do not submit your assignment until instructions and a request for submission are provided directly to you.**

The transcript request form can be accessed at <u>http://www.lynchburg.edu/x4309.xml</u>. Transcripts will be available at the conclusion of each term: mid-May for spring terms, mid-August for summer terms, and late December for fall terms.
